Teachers will be notified of competition results via e-mail by Monday, December 13. Teachers may accompany their students as long as the teacher is unable to be identified in the video.

Winners will be presented on a concert by the Timberline Orchestra under the direction of Devin Hughes on Saturday, January 15, 2011, at 7:30 p.m, at the Mountain View United Methodist Church in Boulder, CO. Winners must be available for the concert and dress rehearsal at 7:00 pm January 14.
