

## CSMTA 2018 Conference: Call for Presentations

The 2018 Conference will be held Thursday-Saturday, May 31-June 2, 2018, at the University of Northern Colorado School of Music, Frasier Hall, 1710 9<sup>th</sup> Ave., Greeley, CO.

**Formal Session:** A 50-minute presentation in a classroom setting on a music-related topic. Topics to consider include (but are not limited to): composition, technique, repertoire, collaborative performance, business policies, or other studio and performance-related topics that address the needs and interests of music instructors. To apply, please submit via email:

1. A Microsoft Word document containing:
  - Presenter's information (name, phone number, email)
  - 80-word bio
  - Session title (in its final form) and Session abstract (250-word maximum)
  - A 35-word bio (to be printed in the conference booklet in the case of a successful proposal)
  - A 35-word session description (to be printed in the conference booklet in the case of a successful proposal)
2. A headshot that meets the following specifications:
  - minimum 300 dpi (this info should be visible under the "file or image info" by right-clicking on the image)
  - does not exceed 1.5MB
  - attach this file to your email; do not embed in the email body

**Poster Presentation:** A visual presentation of information for display. Authors present and describe the work, provide handouts, and answer questions at the designated Poster Session times. Typical categories include (but are not limited to): research, studio/pedagogy projects, and practical teaching information. To apply, please submit the following via email:

1. A Microsoft Word document containing:
  - Presenter's information (name, institutional affiliation, e-mail, telephone)
  - A 35-word bio
  - Poster title (in its final form) and 35-word poster description
  - A JPEG or PDF file of the proposed poster
2. A headshot that meets the following specifications:
  - minimum 300 dpi (this info should be visible under the "file or image info" by right-clicking on the image)
  - does not exceed 1.5MB
  - attach this file to your email; do not embed in the email body

Information on posters should be visible from 3-4 feet away. Successful applicants will be required to provide a professionally printed poster on 36" x 48" tri-fold poster board. Printing can be done relatively cheaply at places such as Alpha Graphics, which has locations all over the Front Range.

### PRESENTATION DEADLINES:

November 1, 2017: Formal Session application submissions.

May 1, 2018: Poster Session.

Applications that do not adhere to the formatting and content rules will not be considered.
